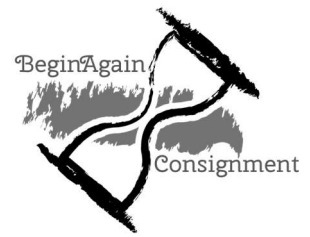


Consignment Agreement

This Consignment Agreement ("Agreement") is made between BeginAgain Consignment, LLC ("Consignee") and the Consignor listed below as of the date provided in the signature section.

1. Items for Consignment

A scheduled appointment is preferred, but not required, to review and accept the goods being consigned. Please schedule each appointment with a maximum of 20 items, 5 of which can be furniture. All acceptable items are recorded in our consignment software and the consignee will determine the selling price based on style, condition and current customer trends/demands. We only accept functional, undamaged, clean, washed, odor-free branded goods that match current trends and seasons. Due to allergies, we are unable to accept furniture and upholstered items from a smoking or pet friendly home.

2. Term of Consignment & Unsold Items

The initial term of this consignment agreement is 60 days, starting from the date of delivery.

Unsold items after this period will be:

- Returned to the Consignor (must be picked up within 10 days after initial term expiration)
- Donated to the Consignee (defaults to donation if not picked up within the 10-day window)

3. Pricing & Markdowns

Pricing is set as listed unless both parties agree to a discount or sales price. The Consignee will apply a discount of 20% after 45 days into the initial term. Consignors are required to participate in the store's periodic promotions which are typically discounted between 10%-20%. Consignors will be notified in advance of discounts over 20%.

4. Commission & Payment

All consigned items are a 50%/50% commission split of the final selling price. Payments will be issued within 15 days after an item is sold. Choose to spend your Consignor's earnings within the store and receive a 10% Consignor's credit on your purchase.

5. Ownership & Risk

The Consignor retains ownership of all items until sold. The Consignee agrees to take sufficient care of the items but is not liable for damage, loss, or theft. The consignor confirms that the consigned goods are their property and not counterfeit products. The goods do not become the property of the consignee; the consignee is only authorized to sell the goods provided to them.

6. Legal & Miscellaneous

This agreement is governed by the laws of the state of Virginia. Modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties. Both parties affirm they are legally able to enter into this agreement and may terminate this agreement with a 7-day written notice.
